Bone Marrow Transplant Unit Opens

Newly Opened Neely Pediatric Bone Marrow Transplant Unit Benefits Patients and Families Immediately

After careful planning and collaboration with physicians, nurses, patients, families, architects, and hospital administration, The Neely Pediatric Bone Marrow Transplant Unit in The Floating Hospital for Children at Tufts Medical Center opened for patients and families late summer 2008.



Bone marrow transplantation is a treatment recommended for certain pediatric cancer patients as a life-saving therapy. For the transplant to be successful, the child needs to live in a germ-free environment for six weeks in order to be safe while their immune system is being suppressed and new cells are transplanted. Even in the cleanest environments, germs are present and can be life-threatening to a child undergoing this procedure. Customarily, parents and siblings who visit children during transplant are required to wear protective scrubs and masks in order to keep the child as safe as possible. In addition to being a long and lonely hospital stay, children often feel isolated due to these careful steps that need to be taken.

With the goal of providing a safe, comfortable and warm home-away-from-home for pediatric cancer patients and their families during this six week period, The Neely Pediatric Bone Marrow Transplant Unit was designed. Great care and thoughtful planning led to this beautifully designed 5,900 square foot space where there are no barriers between parent and child. Featuring a state-of-the-art complex air filtration system, young patients and their families can live together during transplant recovery in a beautiful and friendly setting that is both home-like and clinically state-of-the-art.

Every single design and structural decision was made with these impressionable children and their families in mind. Bright sunlight fills each patient room that is furnished with a pull-out bed for family members and a flat screen television.

“The Floating Hospital for Children at Tufts Medical Center prides itself on family centered care where we consider the whole family’s well being as important to every child getting better,” says John Schreiber, MD, Chief Administrative Officer of the Floating Hospital for Children at Tufts Medical Center. “The incredible new Neely BMT Unit allows us to ‘walk the walk’—parents can stay during the many days of care required for a bone marrow transplant right next to their child. They are part of the physician and nurse care plans, they are an integral part of every child getting better. We are very grateful for the generosity of many who have allowed us to really change the way children get bone marrow transplants in New England,” he says.

Update:

The Michael Neely Center for Brain Tumor Care and Research

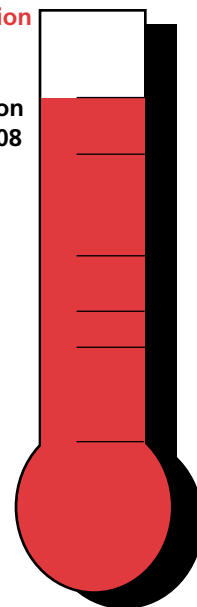
The Cam Neely Foundation for Cancer Care pledged \$5 million to Tufts Medical Center to establish and name The Michael Neely Center for Brain Tumor Care and Research in 2005. As of November, 2008, over \$4 million toward this total has been raised.

This Center was conceived to honor the memory of Michael Neely, the beloved father of Cam, Chris, Scott and Shaun, who lost his brave battle with brain cancer in November 1993.

While the final portion of the pledge is being realized, thousands of patients have already benefited from the redesigned outpatient Neurosurgery Department. Since early 2006, the newly redesigned clinical and administrative areas have provided neurosurgery patients a comfortable and elegant environment for their consults and follow up appointments.

In September 2008, the Minimally Invasive Neurosurgical Operating Suite was in use for patients requiring delicate neurosurgical procedures in this state-of-the-art surgical suite. Foundation support invested in leading-edge neurosurgical operating equipment and technologies, including top resolution monitors suspended from ceiling tracks that adjust to the perfect placement for neurosurgeons performing these highly exacting surgeries.

For patients with brain tumors, as with other patients requiring neurosurgical care, minimally invasive techniques can dramatically minimize the effects of surgery. Benefits include a smaller incision, less anesthesia, a significant decrease in pain, and a shortened length of recovery.

Work will begin in 2009 to realize the final step in this project — the all-new, state-of-the-art, 12-bed Neuroscience Intensive Care Unit (ICU). This specially designed inpatient area will feature a number of bay windows that provide patients and their families with the warmth of natural sunlight. The nurse workstations will be distributed throughout the unit, rather than in a single central location. This floor plan will keep the nurse accessible to the patient at all times. Each patient room will have its own private bathroom, family sitting area and window. Specially designed ceiling mounted booms will assist the staff with patient transport. These booms will help the nurses move even seriously ill patients out of bed and into a chair. This patient movement helps prevent pneumonia and deep vein thrombosis. A consultation room directly outside of the patient rooms will enable quiet and private discussions with the physician/surgeon. A spacious family waiting area at the entrance to the unit will provide a private, warm environment for families when not in a patient's room.

2008 represented significant milestones achieved by the Foundation, highlighted by the opening of The Neely Pediatric Bone Marrow Transplant Unit at the Floating Hospital for Children. Ours is the only BMT unit in the region that includes parent sleeping rooms and communal areas right on the floor within a Hepa-filtered environment. It is the epitome of family-centered care that moves families closer together and increases their time together during a difficult treatment process. All of this is performed in a controlled environment and allows families to spend time in a warm and comfortable home-like space to have some separation in order to “decompress,” while only being footsteps away from their child.


We recently opened a Neurosurgical Minimally Invasive Operating Suite as part of our ongoing \$5 million pledge to create The Michael Neely Center for Brain Tumor Care and Research. This state-of-the-art operating suite will enable neurosurgeons to perform less invasive brain surgery using leading-edge neurosurgical operating equipment.

And, 2009 will mark two more significant achievements as we near funding of a Pediatric Hematology/Oncology Outpatient Clinic and a twelve-bed Neurosurgery Intensive Care Unit.



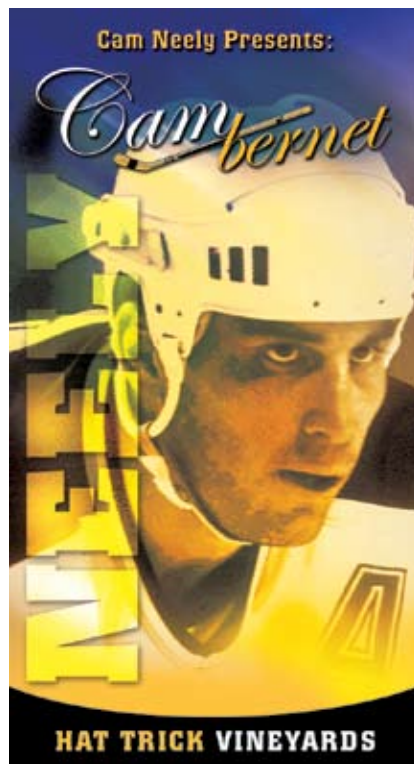
